

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROGRAMME:**

### **(a) Structure of the Programme**

- (i) The Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) candidates spend a minimum of four (4) years on the programme while the direct entry candidates spend a minimum of three (3) years.
- (ii) In his/her final year, a student is also required to carry out a project supervised by an academic staff of the Department.

In addition to the general University entry requirements, candidates must possess any of the following:

### **(b) Admission through Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME)**

- (i) Credit passes in English Language, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and any other science subject at not more than 2 sittings in GCE O/L, WASSCE, SSCE or NECO. A credit in Further Mathematics would be an advantage.
- (ii) Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) subjects are English Language, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry.

### **(c) Admission Through Direct Entry**

- (i) At least 2 passes at GCE A/L, HSC, IJMB or approved equivalents and at least credit passes in 3 relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics at GCE O/L, WASSCE, SSCE, NECO or approved equivalents at not more than 2 sittings.
- (ii) At least two (2) passes at merit level or above in 2 relevant subjects at ND, HND or approved equivalents and at least credit passes in 3 relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics at GCE O/L, WASCE, SSCE, NECO or approved equivalents.

Application for direct entry programme shall be through the Joint Admission Matriculation Board (JAMB) and eligible candidates will be subjected to a screening test.
