

5. ENTRY MODE

Admission into the degree programme of the department of Political Science is through the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) conducted by the Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) or Direct Entry.

6. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: (4 - Year Full-Time Degree Programme)

In addition to satisfying the general requirements of the University and the Faculty of Social Sciences, applicants are required to have credit passes in five (5) subjects including Government, English Language, Mathematics and other Social Science subjects at GCE O/L, WASCE, SSCE, NECO at not more than two sittings.

7. DIRECT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: (3-Year Full Time Degree Programme)

Applicants for the three – year B.Sc degree programme in Political Science must satisfy the general requirements of the University and the Faculty of Social Sciences. They must possess any of the following qualifications:

Two (2) passes at GCE A/L, HSC, and IJMB with a minimum of two Social Science subjects including Government and at least credit passes in three (3) other subjects including English Language, Government and Mathematics at GCE O/L, WASCE, SSCE, NECO at not more than two sittings.

Two (2) passes at merit level or above in two (2) recognized NCE, OND, HND subjects and at least credit passes in three (3) other subjects including English Language, Government and Mathematics at GCE O/L, WASCE, SSCE, NECO at not more than two sittings.
